# **TechnoWise Group Announces Advisory Board Appointment**

From 2003-2011, Mr. Carrillo served on the Texas Railroad Commission – the state’s chief regulatory agency over oil and gas exploration and production – serving twice as Chairman. During his service there he also served as Chairman of the Governor’s Texas Energy Planning Council, Chairman of the Outer Continental Shelf Advisory Committee to the U.S. Secretary of the Interior, Vice Chairman of the Interstate Oil and Gas Compact Commission, and member of the Unconventional Resources Technology Advisory Committee to U.S. Secretary of Energy.

Carrillo is currently on the advisory board of the Maguire Energy Institute at Southern Methodist University.

Mr. Carrillo earned a B.S. degree in Geology from Hardin-Simmons University, an M.S. degree in Geology (emphasis in Geophysics) from Baylor University, and a J.D. in Law from the University of Houston.

“Victor Carrillo’s long history of public service in Texas, coupled with his vast business experience in the oil and gas industries, brings to our Advisory Board unique and unparalleled qualities,” Zaga stated.

Zaga added that the members of the Advisory Board would advise the company on operational, marketing and industry-related issues.
